FREE CHRISTMAS DAY BUSES IN KEIGHLEY 2018.

Carrying on a 24 year tradition, once again a free bus service will run in Keighley on Christmas Day 25th December 2018. As last year it will be operated by fully qualified volunteers from the Town & District Transport Trust based in West Yorkshire and East Lancashire. All the drivers are fully qualified PCV licence holders. The buses we shall use on service were built in the 1990's, and whilst not really vintage in the true sense of the word they will provide a warm and comfortable journey during this cold part of the year.

The free services will run from 10.00 to 16.00 to the same well established timetable that has run in previous years. Three routes will be in operation:

The 17 to Oakworth and return via Fell Lane.

The 18 circular route to Guard House and Braithwaite

The 19 Oxenhope and Haworth to the Town Centre and on to Airedale Hospital

The main bus stop for these services will be outside Wetherspoons The Livery Rooms on North Street and service 17 & 18 also pass the Cricketers Arms and the Brown Cow at the bottom of West Lane.

No fares will be charged on these services and the volunteers are giving their time freely. This will ensure a service is available to local residents and visitors to visit the hospital or visit the town centre pubs for a drink, or even talk the bus to go for a walk in the beautiful countryside surrounding Keighley.
