- Managing finances & debt advice

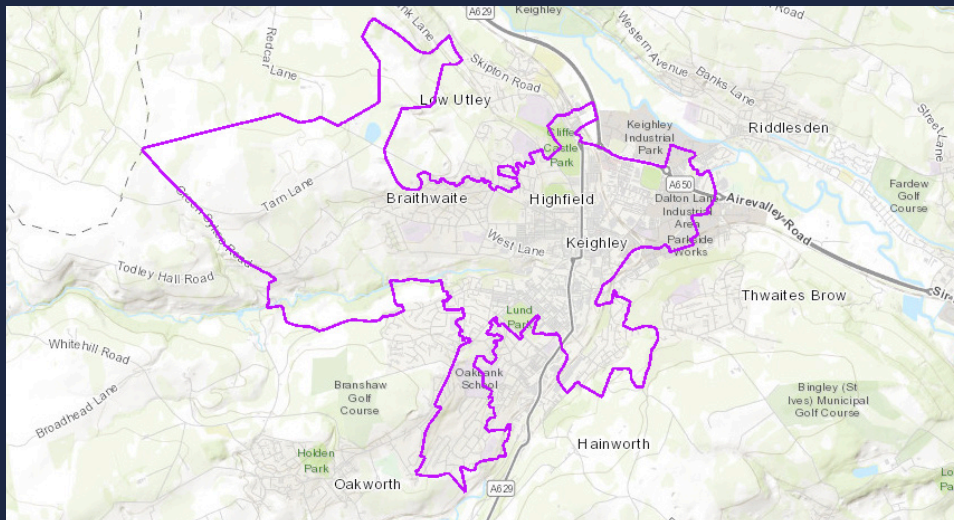
